SU-6 has both a side-mounted and a rear-mounted high-flow discharge which can pump the rig's 1500 feet of 5-inch LDH.

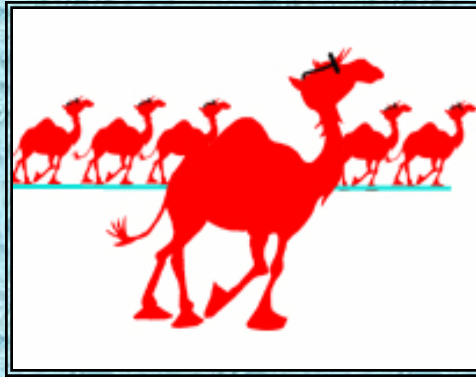

Facts & Figures...

- Special Unit 6 is a specialized water supply piece operated by the Pleasant Valley Community Fire Company located in Carroll County, Maryland. The unit's primary function is as a drafting piece for use at ponds, streams, pools, and underground tanks. Its design allows for versatile use in a variety of rural water supply operations.
- The vehicle itself is a 2003 International 4x4 chassis with a 1500 gpm front-mount pump. The rig was built by 4-Guys and carries 1500-feet of 5-inch hose and 300-feet of 3-inch supply hose.
