Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 446 is a 3000-gallon tanker operated by the Hereford VFC located in Baltimore County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 2005 New Lexington tanker built on a Peterbilt chassis.
- It is powered by a 430 hp Caterpillar motor and has a 1250 gpm Hale Q-Max single-stage pump.
- The tanker carries a 3500-gallon dump tank.

This 3000-gallon tanker is a “big water” hauler that is set-up very nicely for delivering water in any rural water supply operation.

This dump chute is controlled remotely from the cab so that driver never has to leave the rig – which is ideal for reducing dump time.

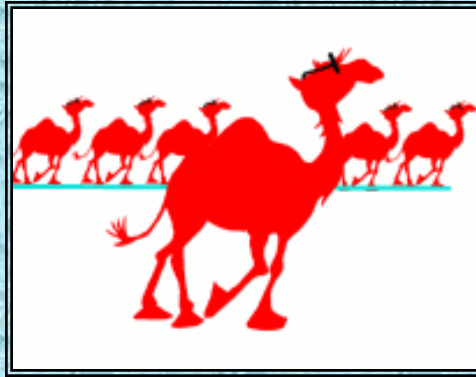


The elliptical tank shape allows for a lower profile which provides for a more stable drive and a lower center of gravity.
