- Tanker 454 is a 2,640-gallon tanker operated by the Maryland Line VFC located in Baltimore County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 1997 New Lexington tanker built on a Freightliner FL112 chassis.
- It has a 1000 gpm Darley single-stage pump and carries a 3000-gallon dump tank.

This elliptical tanker is designed to run on the rolling hills of Baltimore County, MD. The tank design allows for a lower profile which improves the handling of the vehicle over the local terrain.

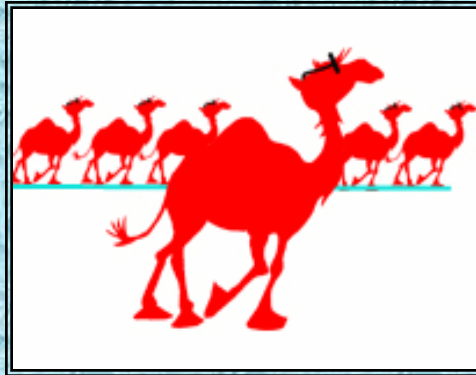


Shown here in action at a local water supply drill, Tanker 454 is equipped with both a rear and side dumps as well as a large, capacity direct fill line on the rear.
