Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 714 is a 3000-gallon tanker operated by the Upper Montgomery County VFD located in Montgomery County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 1993 Walker Stainless tanker built on a Freightliner chassis.
- It has a 1250 gpm Hale pump and carries a 4000-gallon dump tank.
- Tanker 714 and its 3500-gallon sister tanker (717) operated by the Laytonville VFD were the first two, large capacity elliptical tankers purchased in Montgomery County.



This 1993 elliptical tanker is of one of six large capacity tankers operated by the Montgomery County Fire and Rescue Service.



The 1250 gpm pump allows for pumping off the tanker's water until a dump tank operation can be established.



Tanker 714 carries a 4000-gallon dump tank which is large enough to hold the tanker's contents. This is important in a tanker shuttle operation – we don't want to wait to dump all of the water. We want to dump and move!



Tanker 714 is outfitted with a 10-inch Ziamatic, square dump on the rear of the rig.



The tanker is also equipped with a 5-inch direct fill-line.



Nothing fancy here. A plain old butterfly valve controls this intake. Simple and reliable.



Tanker 714 is equipped with 8-inch, round side dumps that have extending tubes. They are controlled remotely.
