Facts & Figures...

- Engine Tanker 112 is a 2,500-gallon tanker operated by the Harney VFC located in Carroll County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 2004 Pierce engine tanker built on an Dash chassis.
- It has a 1250 gpm, single-stage Waterous pump and carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.
- The unit is powered by a Detroit 60 Series motor and is equipped with 10-inch side and rear dumps.
- The Harney VFC protects a small area near the Pennsylvania border in Central Maryland and responds to calls in both hydranted and non-hydranted areas.

This 2004 engine tanker is well- equipped to deliver a “big punch” anywhere in the Harney response district. The rig also has both Class A and Class B foam capabilities.

The rig was built by Pierce on a Dash chassis and is equipped with a 1,500-gpm Waterous pump.

Engine Tanker 112 carries 1,200-ft of 5-inch LDH and is equipped with a pre-connected TFT Blitzfire line.

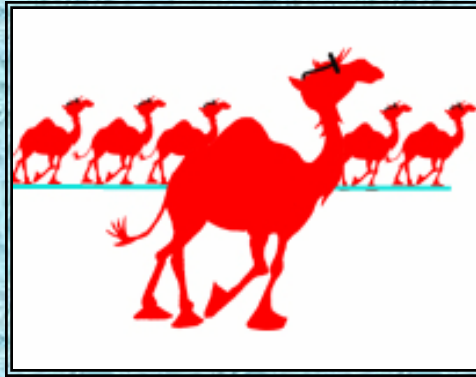


Engine Tanker 112 has a high-flow discharge on the officer side pump panel and is capable of flowing large volumes of water through 5-inch LDH.

The rig carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank neatly stored on a hydraulic lift on the officer side of the unit.
