Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 6 is a 3,200-gallon tanker operated by the Pleasant Valley & Community VFC located in Carroll County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 2008, 4-Guys tanker built on an International chassis.
- It has a 1,500 gpm, single-stage Hale QMax pump and carries a 3,500-gallon dump tank.
- Tanker 6 was purchased to improve water supply delivery in Pleasant Valley's first-due area and it is one of only two, large elliptical tankers in Carroll County.
- The Pleasant Valley VFC protects a large portion of north central Carroll County all the way to the Pennsylvania state line.

Pleasant Valley Tanker 6



Tanker 6 is equipped with a 1,500 gpm pump so that it can serve as a nurse tanker if needed while a dump site is being set up.

The rig's high-flow discharge allows it to directly support an attack engine if needed.

Tanker 6 is powered by a Caterpillar C13 motor and it is also outfitted with a few, pre-connected attack lines in case the tanker needs to serve as an attack piece in certain situations.

The low profile of the tank allows for better road handling and a safer ride.

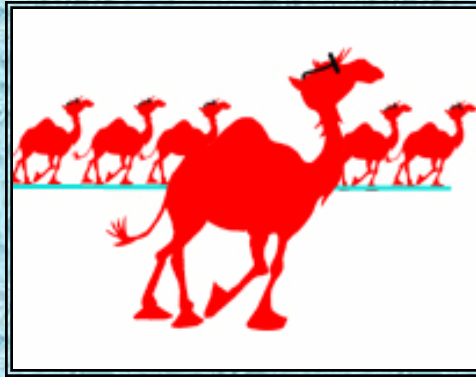


Tanker 6 has three, 10-inch square dumps that are controlled in the cab and on the exterior of the vehicle. The tanker also is outfitted with dual, 5-inch direct fill lines which allow for rapid filling.
