Facts & Figures...

- Engine 3 is really a 3,000-gallon elliptical tanker operated by the Aroney VFD located in southwestern DeKalb County, Alabama.
- The rig is a 2007 Blue Grass tanker built on an International chassis and is powered by a 330 hp International motor.
- The tanker has a Darley, 1250 gpm, single-stage pump and carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.
- Engine 3 was purchased through Federal grant money and has improved Aroney VFD's water delivery capability.
- The Aroney VFD protects a very rural area in the northeastern part of Alabama.

Aroney Engine 3



This 2007, elliptical tanker was one of a couple rigs purchased in DeKalb County, Alabama through the Federal grant process. While it basically serves as a tanker, it also carries a few, pre-connected attack lines to allow it to function as an engine if needed.

The rig is outfitted with a Darley LDM 1250 gpm single-stage pump and carries a couple of pre-connected attack lines plus 250-ft of 4-inch hose. Engine 3 also carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.

The vehicle is power by an International 330 hp diesel motor and has an automatic transmission.

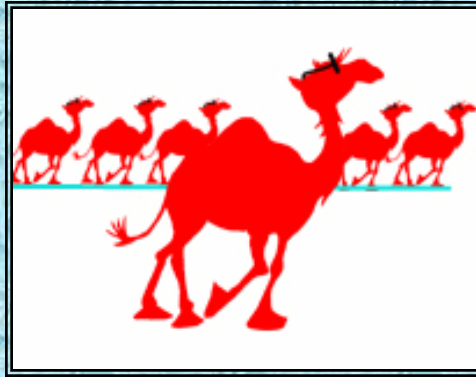


One unique feature of the Aroney piece is the 2-1/2-inch discharge located just below the front bumper. In the photos above, the discharge is shown being used to supply water to a pumper.

The rig is also equipped with both a 4-inch and a 2-1/2-inch direct fill. The 4-inch direct fill is shown above being used at a recent rural water supply drill held in Sylvania, Alabama.
