### Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 836 is a 2,250-gallon tanker operated by the Baden Volunteer Fire Department located in Prince George's County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 1986 4-Guys tanker built on an R-Model Mack chassis and powered by a Mack diesel motor.
- It has a Hale QSMG 1,000 gpm pump and is outfitted with a 10-inch rear dump.
- The Baden VFD protects a rural area of southern Prince George's County.

This 1986 tanker is built to work as a water hauling rig. It carries a minimum amount of fire fighting equipment – but it can certainly haul water!

Tanker 36 (radio designation 836) is shown above being filled by a 5-inch line at a 2008 water supply drill in their community. This direct fill and the use of LDH make short work of the filling operation.
