Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 1 is a 2,800-gallon tanker operated by the LaPlata Volunteer Fire Department located in Charles County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 2001 Pierce tanker built on a Kenworth chassis.
- It has a Hale QPak 750 gpm pump and carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.
- Tanker 1 also carries 200 gallons of foam.
- The LaPlata VFD protects a rural/suburban area of southern Maryland.



Tanker 1 is a really a 3,000-gallon elliptical tanker that has a 200-gallon foam "cell" in it. The rig is equipped with a Hale Qpak 750 gpm pump and has a couple of preconnect crosslays.



Tanker 1 is outfitted with large, side dumps and carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.



Shown here off-loading water via a side dump, Tanker 1 is set-up very nicely to off-load its water in a very short period of time.



Perhaps the most impressive features of the tanker are the 12-inch dump and the dual, 5-inch direct fill lines.
