Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 221 is a 3,000-gallon tanker operated by the Border City Fire Department located in the Finger Lakes Region of New York.
- The rig is a 2006, Midwest PT3 Series elliptical tanker built on a Freightliner chassis.
- It has a Darley 750 gpm pump and is outfitted with 10-inch side and rear dumps.
- The Border City FD protects a semi-rural area of Seneca County, New York.



This 2006 tanker is built on a Freightliner chassis and carries 3,000 gallons of water and a 3,000-gallon portable dump tank.



The tanker is a stainless steel wrapped poly tank that has both side and rear dumps – 10-inch in size.

 Tanker 221 is equipped with a 750 gpm pump and carries a limited amount of hose and related equipment.





The Border City tanker is shown above dumping water at a water supply drill in nearby Ovid, NY.



The tanker also has a 4-inch direct fill line and is shown above using that fill line during a water supply drill.
