Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 321 is a 2,000-gallon tanker operated by the Canoga Fire Department located in the Finger Lakes Region of New York.
- The rig is a locally fabricated tanker built on an International chassis.
- It has a Honda 250 gpm portable pump and is outfitted with 10-inch rear and side dumps.
- The Canoga FD protects a semi-rural area of Seneca County, New York.



This 2,000-gallon tanker is built on a single-axle, International chassis.



The short wheelbase makes for easy maneuvering over the winding roads in the Canoga FD's response district.



The tanker was fabricated locally and is designed to simply haul water. It carries a small, 250 gpm portable pump but uses its 10-inch dumps for offloading its water.



In addition to the rear dump, the rig also has two, 2-1/2-inch direct fill lines – one of which is outfitted with a 4-inch Storz adaptor – shown above.



Tanker 321 is shown here dumping its water at a water supply drill in nearby Ovid, NY. This smaller tanker can offload very quickly and get back on the road for another load.
