Facts & Figures...

- Tanker 421 is a 2,400-gallon tanker operated by the Fayette Fire Department located in the Finger Lakes Region of new York.
- The rig is a 2004, PolyBilt tanker built on a Peterbilt chassis and powered by a 325 hp Cummins diesel motor.
- The entire body is constructed of a copolymer and the tank is an integrated part of the vehicle body.
- It carries a Honda-powered, 350 gpm portable pump and is equipped with 10-inch rear and side dumps.
- The Fayette FD protects a rural area of Seneca County, New York.



This 2004 "plastic" tanker is a compact, big water hauler! Its copolymer body allows for 2,400 gallons of water to be hauled on a single-axle.



A unique feature of the design is that the tank is an integral part of the body. The rear and side dumps and large direct fill make this rig fast at loading and off-loading.



The tanker's short wheelbase makes it quite maneuverable on the winding roads of Seneca County.



In addition to a 10-inch rear dump, Tanker 421 also has a 4-inch direct fill line and carries a portable dump tank (or "pond" as they say in the area).
