# Facts & Figures...

- 8-Tanker-1 is a 2,500-gallon tanker operated by the Gilford Fire Department located in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire.
- The rig is a 2003, KME tanker built on a Mack chassis and powered by a 400 hp Mack motor.
- It has a single-stage, Hale 1,250 gpm pump, a 2,500-gallon tank, and carries two dump tanks.
- The Gilford FD protects a semi-rural area of central New Hampshire.

# Gilford 8-Tanker-1



8-Tanker-1 carries 2,500-gallons of water and is equipped with a mid-ship mounted fire pump.



# Gilford 8-Tanker-1

- The tanker's 1,250 gpm pump is useful when the tanker is needed in a "nurse tanker" operation.
- It also has a couple of pre-connected crosslays and a pre-pied deck gun.





# Gilford 8-Tanker-1



8-Tanker 1 carries two dump tanks – a 2,500 gallon and a 2,000 gallon.



# Gilford 8-Tanker-1



- The rig also has 400 feet of 4-inch LDH.
- The tanker is equipped with a 10-inch rear dump and a 4-inch direct fill line.

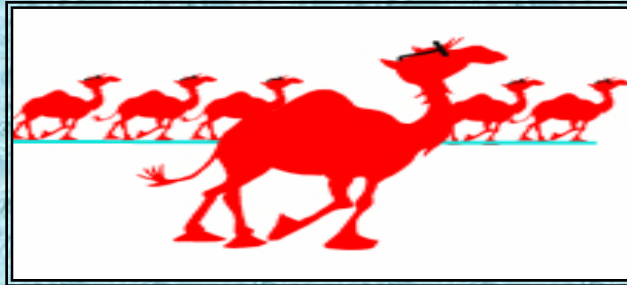


# Gilford 8-Tanker-1



In terms of side dumps, the tanker has an 8-inch dump on each side making it quite versatile when hauling water.
