Facts & Figures...

- 9-Engine-3 is a 2,000 gpm/2,500-gallon engine/tanker operated by the Gilmanton Fire Department located in the Lakes Area of New Hampshire.
- The rig is a 2005, Ahrens Fox engine/tanker built on an HME chassis and powered by a Cummins motor.
- It has a Hale 2,000 gpm pump, a 2,500-gallon tank, and carries 2,000 feet of 4-inch hose.
- The Gilmanton FD protects a semi-rural area of central New Hampshire.



This engine/tanker is one of several that serve the Lakes Region area of central New Hampshire – big pump, big tank, big hose.



 The 2,000 gpm pump on this rig allows it to flow big water as either an attack engine or a water supply piece.



This 2005 engine/tanker is also equipped with a 10-inch rear dump and a 4-inch direct fill line.



The engine/tanker is well-equipped for water supply and fire attack operations. In addition to the basic equipment it also carries Class A foam and a Turbo Draft.
