- Tanker 821 is a 1,500-gallon tanker operated by the Lodi Volunteer Fire Company located in Seneca County, New York.
- The rig is a 1996, 4-Guys tanker built on a Ford chassis.
- It has a Hale AP50 500 gpm pump and is outfitted with a 2-1/2-inch rear fill and a 10-inch rear dump.
- The tanker carries a 1,500-gallon dump tank.
- The Lodi VFC protects a rural area of Seneca County in the Finger Lakes Region of New York.
