Meredith 14-Tanker-5 1,250-gpm/2,500-gallon Engine/Tanker Meredith FD Meredith, New Hampshire

## Facts & Figures...

- 14-Tanker-5 is a 2,500-gallon engine/tanker operated by the Meredith Fire Department located in the Lakes Region of new Hampshire.
- The rig is a 1988, Pierce engine/tanker built on a Pierce custom chassis and powered by a Detroit diesel motor.
- It has a Waterous 1,250 gpm single-stage pump and is outfitted with a 6-inch rear dump.
- The Meredith FD protects a rural area of central New Hampshire.



This 1988 engine/tanker is set-up to function as both an attack engine and as a water supply piece if needed.

- The engine/tanker has a top mounted pump panel, two preconnected crosslays, and a prepiped deck gun.
- The rig also has dual, 3inch tank-to-pump lines to improve flow when pumping off water in a nurse tanker mode.






The rig also carries more than the traditional 20-feet of suction hose because folks in the rural environment know that additional suction is often needed to access draft sites or to support dump tank operations.



14-Tanker-5 carries 2,500 gallons of water and 1,100 feet of 4-inch supply hose.



14-Tanker-5 is shown here offloading water at a water supply drill in nearby Ashland, NH. The rig has a 6-inch rear dump and a 3-inch direct fill line outfitted with a 4-inch Storz fitting.
