Facts & Figures...

- 15-Engine-4 is a 1,250 gpm pumper operated by the Moultonborough Fire Department located in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire.
- The rig is a 2001, Central States pumper built on an HME chassis and powered by a 400 hp Caterpillar diesel motor.
- It has a Hale 1,250 gpm single stage pump and carries 1,200 feet of 4-inch hose.

This 2001 Central States pumper is designed to function as both an attack engine and a water supply piece.

- The rig has a 1,250 gpm pump with a top mounted pump panel. It also has several pre-connected attack lines and a pre-piped deck gun

Some departments like a top mounted pump panel because it can give the operator a better view of the emergency scene.

The pumper carries a full complement of engine company tools and has a 1,000 gallon water tank. The pumper also is equipped with a Class A foam system.

15-Engine-4 carries 1,200 feet of 4-inch hose trimmed out with a double-clappered siamese to support a “rural hitch operation”. The rig also has a 2-1/2-inch direct fill line.

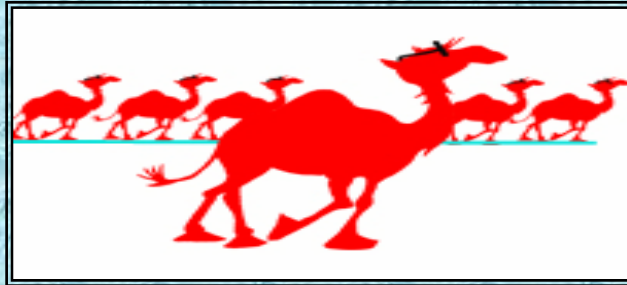


The pumper carries all of its ladders and suction hose inside compartments.
