Facts and Figures...

- Brush Tanker 3 is a homemade tanker operated by the Ramona FD located in Marion County, Kansas.
- The rig is built on a 1977 military-surplus 6WD chassis.
- The tanker has a 175 gpm Waterous pump and carries 1,700 gallons of water.
- It is also equipped with a 10-inch, driver's side dump and 2-1/2" direct fill line on the rear.
- Brush Tanker 3 carries a 3,000 gallon portable dump tank.
- Ramona FD protects the rural, prairie lands of Marion County, Kansas.

This all-wheel drive tanker will go just about anywhere and its 10-inch side dump lets it offload all of its water in about 60 seconds!

Brush Tanker 3 is equipped with a small pump and a couple of attack lines that can be used for fighting prairie fires.
