Facts & Figures...

- Brush 95 is a 1000 gpm brush truck operated by the Reese and Community Volunteer Fire Department located in Carroll County, Maryland.
- The rig is a 2005 KME mini-pumper built on Ford F550 chassis.
- It has a Hale MG 1,000 gpm, single-stage pump and a 250-gallon water tank.
- Brush 85 also carries 500 feet of 4-inch supply hose and an assortment of fire fighting tools and equipment.
- The Reese and Community VFD protects a rural/suburban area of Carroll County - which is located in central Maryland.

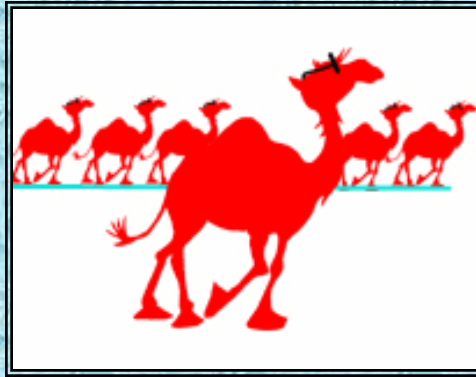


The rig was built by KME and is equipped with a Hale 1,000 gpm midship pump which can support a tanker fill site operation.

Brush 95 is shown above running jet siphons at a water supply drill in nearby Pleasant Valley, MD. The unit established a draft from one dump tank and then supported jet siphons so that water could be transferred to adjacent tanks – thus freeing up pumping capacity for the primary drafting pumper.
