

Beaver Brook FD - Tanker 11 2,500-gallon/500 gpm Pump Danbury, Connecticut

# Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 11 is a 2001 Pierce tanker operated by the Beaver Brook FD located in Danbury, Connecticut.
- The rig is built on a Freightliner chassis and is powered by a 350 hp Cummins diesel motor.
- The engine/tanker has a 500 gpm, single-stage Hale PTO pump and carries 2,500 gallons of water.
- It is also equipped with a 10-inch rear dump; two, 8-inch side dumps, and a 5-inch direct fill line.
- Tanker 11 carries a 3,000 gallon portable dump tank.
- Beaver Brook protects the rural/suburban area around Danbury, Connecticut.



Tanker 11 is one of several large tankers that serve the Danbury area.



The tanker is equipped with a Hale 500 gpm pump and a couple of preconnected attack lines.





The rig has a 10-inch rear and two, direct fill lines – one of which is a 5-inch direct fill. The tanker also carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.
