

Casco Fire/Rescue – Tank 6

1,800 gallon Tanker

Casco, Maine

Facts and Figures...

- Tank 6 is a 1989 tanker operated by the Casco Fire-Rescue Department located in Casco, Maine.
- The rig is built on a Ford chassis and carries 1,800 gallons of water.
- Tank 6 has a 300 gpm PTO driven fire pump and carries a 2,100 dump tank.
- The tanker is equipped with 8-inch, square side dumps and has a dual direct fill lines on the rear.
- The Casco Fire-Rescue, along with several other FDs, protect numerous small town and rural areas in the Lakes Region of Maine.



Tank 6 is a nice, short wheel-based tanker for handling the narrow "camp" roads in the lakes region around Casco.



The tanker has a small, 300 gpm PTO-driven pump that allows it to serve as nurse tanker in a limited manner if needed.



The rig has dual direct fills as well as a round dump on the rear.



Tank 6 also has a hose reel (forestry style) and carries a 2,100-gallon dump tank.



Shown here at a water supply drill in 2012, Tank 6 operates as a nurse tanker (early in the drill) and supplies 250 gpm to an attack pumper via 100-feet of 4-inch supply line.
