## Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 86 is a 2012, 4-Guys tanker operated by the Eastern Garrett County Volunteer Fire and Rescue Department located in Garrett County, Maryland.
- The rig is built on a Peterbilt chassis and is powered by a 500hp Cummins motor..
- Tanker 86 has a Hale 1,000 gpm PTO-driven pump and carries 3,000 gallons of water.
- It is equipped with 10-inch side and rear dumps and carries a 3,000 gallon dump tank.
- The Eastern Garrett County VFRD protects the rural areas near Frostburg and along Interstate 68.



Tanker 86 is a large-capacity tanker that is designed to haul water in the mountainous terrain of Garrett County as well as along the interstate. The tanker is equipped with a 1,000 gpm pump and two, 1-3/4" crosslays.



The 3,000-gallon tanker has dual, 3-inch direct tank fills and carries a variety of equipment to support water supply operations.



The rig is also equipped with a 3,000 gallon dump tank. Known as "The Beast on Big Savage" (Mountain), Tanker 86 is an effective water hauling rig.



The tanker is shown here dumping its water at a training session. The 10-inch dumps allow the tanker to offload its contents very quickly.
