

Golden's Bridge FD – Tanker 1 3,300-gallon Tanker w/1,000 gpm Pump Golden's Bridge, New York

#### Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 1 is a 1988, S & S tanker operated by the Golden's Bridge FD located in Westchester County, New York.
- The rig is built on a White chassis and is powered by a Detroit diesel motor.
- The tanker has a 1,000 gpm, single-stage Darley pump and carries 3,300 gallons of water.
- It is also equipped with a 12-inch rear and a 5-inch direct fill line.
- Tanker 1 does not carry a dump tank.
- The Golden's Bridge FD protects the rural, northern area of Westchester County, New York.



Tanker 1 is a rather unique design in terms of the chassis and pump configuration – it certainly reduces the overall length of the rig.



The 1,000 gpm Darley pump fits nicely into the space between the cab and the tank – although it was probably a bit of a challenge for the fellow running the plumbing! The pump allows the tanker to operate as a relay pumper, a supply pumper, or a nurse tanker if needed.



The business end of Tanker 1 has a 12-inch round dump and two, direct fill lines – one which is equipped with a 5-inch Storz fitting.



Tanker 1 is basically designed to haul water. It carries limited fire hose and equipment but it is certainly set-up to quickly load and off-load its 3,300 gallons.



Note the 5-inch LDH loaded in the crosslay area and the 5-inch LDH discharge on the pump panel – both conveniently located for quick deployment.
