

Lauderdale – La Grange FD Tender 1430 3,000 gallon Tender La Grange, Wisconsin

Facts and Figures...

- Tender 1430 is a 3,000 gallon tender operated by the Lauderdale – La Grange FD located in Jefferson County, Wisconsin.
- The unit was built by U.S. Tanker on a 2008 International chassis and has a 1,000 gpm Darley front mount pump.
- The tender carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank and is equipped with 10" side and rear dumps and has a 5-inch direct fill line.
- Tender 1430 is one of several, large capacity tenders operated by fire departments in Jefferson County, Wisconsin.



Tender 1430 was built by U.S. Tanker – a local Wisconsin builder that is nationally known for its work in the "tender" business. The tender is built to haul water and does a very good job of doing just that!



The rig is equipped with a 1,000 gpm Darley front mount pump making it more versatile in rural water supply operations. With a front mount pump the tender can work as a nurse tender, a supply pumper, or a relay pumper.



Tender 1430 carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank plus an assortment of water supply support equipment.



A 5-inch direct fill line is the standard fill line for all tenders in the mutual aid group to which Lauderdale-La Grange FD belongs. This standardized fitting plays a critical role in the success of large-scale water supply delivery operations like the 1,750 gpm drill in nearby Whitewater in April 2014.
