

Pine Mountain VFD – Tanker 1462 1,800 gallon Tanker Pine Mountain, Alabama

Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 1462 is a 1998, Fouts Brothers tanker operated by the Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department located in central Alabama.
- The rig is built on an International chassis and is powered by a diesel motor.
- Tanker 1462 carries 1,800 gallons of water and has a 250 gpm pump.
- It is equipped with 10-inch side and rear dumps, a 2,000-gallon dump tank, and carries a couple hundred feet of 4-inch hose.
- The Pine Mountain VFD along with several other fire departments protect the small town and rural areas of Blount County, Alabama.



Tanker 1462 is set up to operate as a water hauling unit in a tanker shuttle operation. It has a 250 gpm pump for small scale operational support such as brush/woods fires.



The tanker's short wheel base is ideal for the narrow, windy roads of Blount County.



The rear end of Tanker 1462 is the "business" end of the unit. The rig can dump off either side or rear and the 4-inch direct fill makes for a quick turnaround time at the fill site.



Tanker 1462 carries a 2,000-gallon dump tank in a low position on the unit for easy deployment.



The tanker is shown here dumping its water at a water supply drill in 2010.
