

Pottawatomie Twp. FD – Tanker 3361 3,000-gallon Tanker Pottawatomie, Kansas

Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 3361 is a 2009, tanker operated by the Pottawatamie Township Fire Department located in Franklin County, Kansas.
- The rig is built on an International Navistar chassis and has a 750 gpm PTO-driven Darley pump.
- Tanker 3361 carries 3,000 gallons of water as well as a 3,000-gallon dump tank.
- The tanker has a 10-inch rear dump that also has a detachable, directional chute so that water can be off-loaded to either side of the vehicle.
- The Pottawatamie Twp Fire Department along with several other departments, protect the small town and rural areas of Franklin County, Kansas.



Tanker 3361 is one of several, large capacity tankers operated by departments in Franklin County.



The International Navistar chassis is one of the more popular tanker chassis currently on the market and is used by many tanker manufacturers throughout the USA.



Tanker 3361 has a 750 gpm PTO-driven fire pump and is equipped with a couple of pre-connected attack lines. The tanker does not have a rear tank fill – but has a side-mounted direct tank fill on the pump panel.



The tanker has a 10-inch rear dump and a detachable chute that is used to allow the tanker to dump water off of either side – which also allows compliance with NFPA 1901 for a Mobile Water Supply Apparatus.
