

Pound Ridge FD – Tanker 3
3,550-gallon Tanker w/1000 gpm Pump
Pound Ridge, New York

Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 3 is a 1992, S & S tanker operated by the Pound Ridge
 FD located in Westchester County, New York.
- The rig is built on a Spartan chassis and is powered by a 350 hp Detroit diesel motor.
- The engine/tanker has a 1,000 gpm, singe-stage Waterous pump and carries 3,550 gallons of water.
- It is also equipped with a 12-inch rear dump, two, 8-inch side dumps, and dual, 4-inch direct fill lines.
- Tanker 3 carries a 3,000 gallon portable dump tank.
- The Pound Ridge FD protects the rural, northern area of Westchester County, New York.



Tanker 3 is a large capacity tanker built on a custom Spartan chassis with an S&S body.



The rig is outfitted with a 1,000 gpm Waterous pump and carries a minimal amount of hose. Note the use of an external control valve on the suction intake – it is a hand-operated butterfly valve – often referred to as a "keystone" valve.



The tanker carries jet siphons pre-connected to its 6-inch suction hose. We like this idea – saves time – quicker set-up.



The tanker has a 12" round dump and dual, 4" direct fills on the rear of the rig.



Tanker 3 is equipped with 8" round dumps behind the tandem wheels on both sides of the body. It also carries a 3,000-gallon dump tank.



The tanker is also equipped with an LDH discharge – again – a handy fixture when working as a nurse tanker or a relay pumper.
