3,250-gallon Tanker w/1,500 gpm Pump

Facts and Figures...

- Tanker 2 is a 1998, S & S tanker operated by the South Salem
 FD located in Westchester County, New York.
- The rig is built on a Kenworth chassis and has a 1,500 gpm, single-stage Darley pump.
- The tanker carries 3,250 gallons of water and has a 10-inch rear dump; two, 6-inch side dumps; and a 5-inch direct fill line.
- Tanker 5 carries a 3,300 gallon portable dump tank.
- The South Salem FD protects the rural, northern area of Westchester County, New York.



Tanker 2 is a large capacity tanker designed to haul water – and be good at it!



The rig's 1,500 gpm Darley pump is set-up to handle 5-inch hose as both a supply line and a discharge line. This size pump provides versatility in operation as a supply pumper, a relay pumper, or a nurse tanker.



Tanker 2 has a 10-inch round dump and a 5-inch direct fill line – both allow for quick turn-around times at the dump site and fill site.



The tanker carries a 3,300-gallon dump tank. Note the LDH discharge on the officer side pump panel and the 6-inch round dump just ahead of the tandem wheels.
