Tying Up the Drains

Dump Tank Drain



The position of dump tank drains when packing up after a call is really not important...until of course, the next call when the tank is filled with water.

Dump Tank Drain



This drain was tied up on the outside of the tank when it was last stowed on the tanker. That was - fine until this time - when the tank was filled with water.

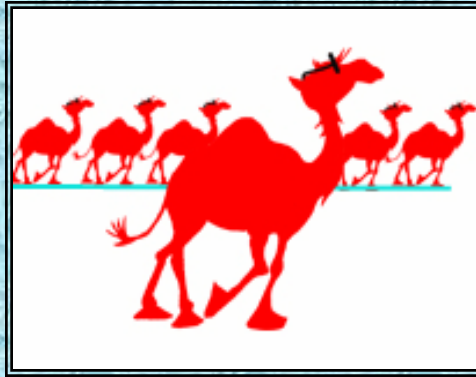
Dump Tank Drain



This is the correct position of the drain when tied up for storage. When filled with water, the water pressure will help keep the drain closed.

Facts & Figures...

- It is the little things that can really make a difference when using portable dump tanks.
- Tying up the drains is one of those little things.
- When putting away a dump tank after a call, take the time to tie up the drains on the **INSIDE** of the tank.
- Once water is dumped into the tank, the pressure of the water will help keep the drain closed and your feet dry!
